CU students lock Sheikh Hasina Hall office

About one hundred residential students of Janonetri Sheikh Hasina Hall in Chittagong University on Thursday kept the hall office under lock and key for about one hour for alleged mismanagement.

The students locked the hall office room at about 10:45am to press home their demand for cleaning the washroom and hall rooms regularly and opening the extended part of the dormitory immediately.

The students, however, unlocked the office at about 11:45am after getting an assurance from the hall authorities to solve the issues within a short time, residential student Aklima Akter told New Age.

‘The students closed the hall office out of anger as they faced mismanagement at the dormitory since its opening,’ she said.

Aklima Akter, also a student of the communication and journalism department, said that they placed a four-point demand to the authorities including opening the extended part of the hall by Sunday and appointing people to clean the washrooms regularly.

Hall provost professor AKM Rezaur Rahman said that they would take decision after consulting with the vice-chancellor regarding the students’ demands.
