

## Medical varsity under active consideration

Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia said in Dhaka Wednesday that the establishment of a medical university in the country was under active consideration of the present government to fulfil the long-standing demand of the physicians, reports BSS.

Addressing the inaugural session of the third national convention of Bangladesh Medical Teachers' Society Federation at the auditorium of Institution of Engineers Bangladesh in Dhaka the Prime Minister said her government would also consider to set up the medical colleges in different parts of the country which were promised by the government of Shaheed President Ziaur Rahman.

Amid standing ovation from the physicians on her announcement, Begum Zia said, "we want to revitalise the health sector, destroyed by the long nine years of autocratic rule, through proper utilisation of our limited resources".

Begum Zia said struggle against autocracy had ended but the movement to reach the fruits of democracy and economy to the people had just started.
