Medical education in Bangla suicidal"

Medical education in Bangla will be suicidal for the country said Prof Matiur Rahman of Institute of Post Graduate Medicine and Research (IPGMR) while talking exclusively to The Morning Sun.

He said, "since the liberation of the country we have already made a mess of our education sector which is now in shambles and there is no hope that things, will improve. But by switching over to Bangla banning English altogether from medical education we will be doing a greater harm to the nation.
