DMC closed sine die

The authorities of Dhaka Medical College (DMC) declared the college closed sine did following an armed clash between the two rival groups of students at the college hostel premises on Monday.

The authorities asked the students to vacate the hostels by 4 p.m. on Monday and most of the students left the dormitories within the stipulated time, college sources said.

According to sources, at least five students were injured during the armed clash which erupted at 3 a.m. between the two student groups over the dispute of a room No. 25 of the Doctors' Hostel of the college.

Activists of ruling party backed Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) captured the room No. 25 belonging to Chhatra League (S-P) leader Mashihur Rahman on September 9 and Chhatra League (S-P) activists in retaliation attacked JCD members on Monday that led to the armed clash leaving five students injured.

During the clash both the groups used fire arms and made chase and counter chase that created panic among the campus inmates.

The injured students are Khorshed Alam of JCD and Firoz, Pulin, Ziaur Rahman Zia and Nasir of Chhatra League (S-P).

The authorities deployed police in and around the hostel premises after the incident.
