Student politics banned in Sher-e-Bangla Medical College

BARISAL, July 10:—The academic council of Shere Bangla Medical College has banned student politics on the college campus for the next three years following continued gunfighting between two student organisations for the last two years.

Sher-e-Bangla Medical College was closed sine die on April 16 following fierce gun fighting between rival student organisations on the college campus. The college hostels were opened for the students on July 6. But the situation on the campus remined tense as the leading student organisations refused to accept the rules framed by the college authorities for allotment of seats among students. Under the circumstances,

the college authorities had no option but to ban student politics on the college campus to maintain law and order and restore academic atmosphere.

Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal and Islami Chhatra Shibir welcomed the decision of the college authorities to ban student politics for three years. Bangladesh Chhatra League, the pro-Awami League student organisation which had been in power in the college students union for the last few years did not make any immediate response to the decision of the college authorities.
