JU BCL activists beat fellow over harassing RU BCL leader

Some Chhatra League leaders of Jahangirnagar University on Wednesday beat up one of their fellows in Mir Mosharraf Hossain Hall for alleged harassment of Rajshahi University unit BCL leader, who came to visit JU.

The Chhatra League fellow who was subjected to beating is Sajib Ahmed, a third-year student of geography and environment department, and also a BCL activist of Mir Mosharraf Hossain Hall.

Allegations had it that Sajib along with his friends harassed and beat Rajshahi University unit BCL vice-president Dibbendu Dibbo, who was found to be taking drug in the JU central playground on Tuesday evening.

The visiting RU student was allegedly beaten a second time in the hall guestroom and demanded of money by Sajib that angered JU unit BCL vice-president Abul Kalam Azad with whom Dibbo had intimacy.

A meeting at the JU hall guestroom was arranged at about 8:00pm on Tuesday attended by JU BCL vice-presidents Abdullah Al Faruk Emran, Shah Paran, Hasan Mahmud Farid, international affairs secretary Mostafizur Rahman, and deputy scholarship affairs secretary Al-Raji Sarker.

At one stage of the meeting, some BCL activists came down hard on Sajib for harassing and beating the RU student on the JU campus.

Sajib received terrible injuries due to random slaps on the ears that caused intense bleeding. He is undergoing treatment at Enam Medical College Hospital in Savar.

'The BCL activists tortured me and my four other mates at the guestroom for about four hours and they prevented me from going to hospital,' said Sajib.

Later, the injured student was taken to JU medical centre where an on-duty doctor referred him to Enam Medical College Hospital.

JU BCL vice-president Hasan Mahmud Farid termed the guestroom incident on Tuesday night a regular organisational meeting.

Talking about bleeding from Sajib's ear, he said, 'It was due to his previous illness, and none was tortured there.'

Emran, Shah Paran, Mostafizur and Al-Raji denied their involvement in the incident.

JU BCL president Akhtaruzzaman Shohel said, 'I don't know about the incident. Organisational actions will be taken against our activists if any of them is found to have attacked any student.'

Mir Mosharraf Hossain Hall provost Md Obaydur Rahman said, 'The RU unit BCL leader is frequently seen in the hall. I have come to know that he comes here to take drug. I have already informed security officials about it.'

Quoting doctors, the provost said that Sajib was advised to keep his ears dry for three months because he ran the risk of eardrum distortion.

JU proctor ASM Firoz-Ul-Hasan said that he saw some students take an injured student to the university medical centre late at night.

'Steps will be taken following investigation if the injured student lodges any complaints,' he added.

RU BCL leader Dibbo refused to comment on his alleged harassment.
