

RAJSHAHI, Aug 6: Rajshahi
Medical College authorities
cancelled admission of about
150 students of first year MBBS
(40th batch).

The students had been absenting from classes without a prior permission from the authorities.

The Academic Council of the college in an emergency meeting last night observed their autovacation as a violation of academic rule.

The AC with the acting-principal Prof. A B Siddiquee in the chair decided that the students would have to take readmission by depositing a fee of Tk 50.00 by Aug 10.

Besides, each student will have to pay a fine of Tk 1000 in addition to the readmission fee after Aug 10, the AC decided.
