Rajshahi nursing students asked to vacate hostels

RAJSHAHI, July 29:—The students of Rajshahi Nursing Institute under Rajshahi Medical College Hospital (RMCH) have been asked to vacate their dormitories by 10.00 a.m. tomorrow (Friday).

The decision was taken in an academic council meeting held at the office of the Director of RMCH on Wednesday evening following a strike for indefinite period called by the nursing students on July 18 to press home their demands for withdrawal of three tutors of the institute.

Meanwhile, the students have rejected the decision of RMCH authorities and brought out a procession in the city protesting the decision. The processionists paraded main thoroughfares of the city chanting slogans demanding immediate withdrawal of the three sister tutors. After the procession they also held a meeting on the RMCH campus.
