

Fresher tortured by IU students again



A first-year student of the human resource management department of Islamic University in Kushtia yesterday lodged a written complaint with the university administration seeking punishment for those involved in torturing him near Birshreshtha Hamidur Rahman Auditorium on the campus.

In his complaint, Tahmin Osman said a group of students from the 2021-22 academic session brought the victim to the Birshreshtha Hamidur Rahman Auditorium area after his orientation class held at the IU business administration faculty building on September 2.

The students misbehaved with the victim and also later bullied him on several occasions, the complaint said.

IU Proctor Prof M Shahadat Hossain Azad told UNB that they formed a five-member probe body and asked it to submit a report within seven working days.

The proctor said they would take stern action against the accused involved in the incident after getting the report from the probe body.

On August 21, university authorities expelled five students, a former leader and four former activists of the Chhatra League, for torturing a first-year female student.
