## 4 nursery schools at divisional hqs. soon

Social Welfare Minister Mr. S.A. Bari A.T. on Tuesday said the Government will try to create necessary atmosphere for the proper development of children in the country and urged the people to come forward and help in making this effort a success, reports BSS.

He was addressing a discussion meeting organised by the Bangladesh UN Association of observance of the World Children Day held at Bangladesh Parishad in Dacca.

He said four nursery schools one at each of the divisional headquarters, will be set up soon for these children whose parents had been killed during the War of Liberation.
