DU suspends 4 'Proloy Gang' members

Four members of the 'Proloy Gang' of Dhaka University have been temporarily expelled for torturing a student at Suhrawardy Udyan in the capital recently.

The expelled were asked to respond within seven working days of receiving the letter as to why they should not be expelled from the university permanently.

The decision was taken at a meeting of the Discipline Council at Nabab Nawab Ali Chowdhury Senate building on Monday with DU vice-chancellor professor ASM Maksud Kamal in the chair, said a press release.

The members of the notorious group known as 'Proloy Gang' on the campus are allegedly involved in drug abuse, extortion, and assaulting outsiders, especially in Suhrawardy Udyan and Shaheed Minar areas at night.

The temporarily expelled are Tabarak Mia of peace and conflict studies department), Mursalin Faiyaz, Faisal Ahmed Sakib of organisation strategy and leadership department and Jubayer Ibne Humayun of criminology department. They are the students of 2020-21 session of the university.

Meanwhile, based on a report of the inter-hall investigation committee formed on the allegation of being involved in various anti-social activities, 14 students of the Gang have also been expelled for 2 months to a maximum of 2 years.

Besides, 49 students have been punished for different periods for cheating in the examinations, according to the release.
