HSC, equivalent exams results today

The results of the Higher Secondary Certificate and its equivalent examinations, 2023 will be published across Bangladesh today.

Bangladesh Inter-Education Board Coordination Committee president and Dhaka board chairman Professor Tapan Kumar Sarker told New Age on Saturday that the results will be published from the educational institutions and online at the same time at 11:00am.

Education minister Dipu Moni will publish the statistics of the results at a press briefing to be held at the International Mother Language Institute in the capital at 2:00pm today, said the ministry officials.

A total of 13,59,342 students have registered for the 2023's HSC and equivalent exams. Of them, 6,88,887 are boys and 6,70,455 are girls.

A notice issued by the Dhaka Education Board on November 21 said that the result sheet can be downloaded from its website (www.dhakaeducationboard.gov.bd) by clicking the result corner and entering the educational institute's identification number.

The result sheet can also be downloaded from the www.educationboardresults.gov.bd by entering roll and registration numbers.

Examinees can also get results through SMS by typing HSC, first three letters of the board's name, roll and year (for example: HSC Dha 123456 2023) and sending this to 16222.

The HSC examinations began simultaneously under the eight general education boards, namely, Dhaka, Rajshahi, Cumilla, Barishal, Dinajpur, Sylhet, Jashore and Mymensingh, on August 17.

The examinations of three boards—Chattogram Education Board, Bangladesh Madrasah Education Board and Bangladesh Technical Education Board—were shifted to August 27 due to flooding in five districts of the Chattogram division.

This year the HSC and equivalent examinations returned to the pre-Covid format and were held on all subjects for a three-hour period.

The average combined pass rate was 85.95 per cent in the 2022 HSC and equivalent examinations, marking a pass rate decline by 9.31 per cent than 2021 with a pass rate of 95.26 per cent.
