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New system for primary final exam

NARSINGDI, Jan. 23.—A total of 1564 students of the different primary schools of Raipura thana under Narsingdi Sub-division appeared at the Primary Final Examination held in December 27. Out of the examinees 1378 students were declared to have passed and the percentage of the successful candidates was 88.1.

It may be mentioned here that the primary school teachers, persons interested in education and the local officials of Raipura thana worked out a new system for holding the Primary Final Examination on centre basis and the Thana Education Officer was appointed controller of the examination earlier.

The whole thana was divided into 15 centres for holding the examination smoothly. Three hundred ninety five students secured first division 552 were placed in second division and 431 passed in third division in the said examination.

This new system of primary examination has created much enthusiasm among the guardians of the area. The students of the different primary schools have also become more attentive to their studies for facing the competitive system.

The examination conducting committee has appealed to the authorities concerned to introduce centre basis primary final examination in all thanas of the Narsingdi Sub-division to raise the standard of the primary education.

Mr. Ataul Karim Finance Director IRDP and Mr. Zahirul Islam, Project Director, Dacca Zone visited Narsingdi and Shibpur Thana Central Co-operative Societies recently. During the visit they met the members of the Tawadi Primary Krishak Samabaha Samity and urged them to work unitedly with the spirit of dedication to help change the economic structure of the rural areas.

The supply of fire wood has markedly gone down at the Narsingdi market for the last few months. This insufficient supply of wood has resulted in the hike of fire wood prices. Thousands of people of the area have been thrown into acute fuel crisis.

It is learnt from the wood sellers that the wood-trees are very scarce in the villages. It may be mentioned here that Titas gas line network passes through the Narsingdi town. Now if the gas line is extended to the consumers both in industrial and domestic areas the fuel problem of Narsingdi and its suburban areas could have been solved very easily it is felt by the people of the area.

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Primary school opens

JOYDEVPUR (Dacca), Jan. 14.—A new primary school was opened at Barabari under Tongi Pourasabha on Friday, reports BSS.

The Sub-divisional Officer, Dacca, Sadar, North inaugurated the school. One hundred and forty five students are being taught in this school which was established three months earlier.

The Subdivisional Officer later laid the foundation stone of the new school building and declared a grant of Taka 5000 for its development.
