Speakers condemned the nationwide killings and chaos, including the recent murder of a female garment worker and the tragic death of 6-year-old Muntaha.

Addressing the gathering, Abdur Rashid Zitu, convener of the Gono Obbhunthan Rokkha Andolon, said, "We are deeply concerned about the deteriorating security situation across the country. We urge

the police to take an active role in ensuring public safety. Additionally, we call on the university administration to install CCTV cameras at various locations on campus to enhance campus security."
