
Seminar on biomechanics of mental health held at UIU

United International University's civil engineering department organised a seminar titled Biomechanics of Mental Health on its campus at Madani Avenue in Dhaka on Tuesday.

University of Illinois' mechanical science and engineering department professor Md Taher Abu Saif was present as keynote speaker while Professor ABM Badruzzaman, vice-chancellor, BUET, was present as guest of honour at the seminar, which was presided over by executive director of Institute for Advanced Research, UIU, Professor Emeritus M Rezwan Khan, said a press release on Thursday.
