

MASS UPRISING: SUST suspends 29 BCL activists

Shahjalal University of Science and Technology authorities suspended 29 students, all leaders and activists of the banned student organisation Bangladesh Chhatra League, for their involvement in attacks on participants of the anti-discrimination students' movement.

An official notice, signed by the university's acting registrar Syed Salim Mohammed Abdul Kadir, announced the decision on Sunday.

According to the notice, the university syndicate took the decision in a recent meeting based on recommendations from the disciplinary board. The board investigated the attacks, which occurred between July 15 and August 5, targeting students involved in the anti-discrimination movement.

The syndicate also formed an investigative committee to determine additional punitive measures against the suspended students.
