

IUB holds 25th convocation

INDEPENDENT University, Bangladesh held its 25th convocation at the university campus of Bashundhara Residential Area in Dhaka on Saturday.

The IUB's 1,969 students were conferred on undergraduate and postgraduate degrees at the convocation, said a press release.
