

BUET-Alberta Varsity research cooperation accord

A Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) under "Link programme" has been signed between Bangladesh University of Engineering & Technology (BUET) and University of Alberta,

Canada with an objective to initiate bilateral co-operation in the field of engineering education and research.

Professor M. H. Khan, Vice-Chancellor, BUET and Prof. Brian Evans, Associate Vice-President, University of Alberta have signed the MOU on Monday.

Under the 5-year programme, some faculty members of BUET will be awarded scholarship as visiting Professor for research and to conduct Ph.D. programme. Alberta University will also supply scientific instruments and will help BUET offer new courses in the field of energy, specially in petroleum and water resources engineering.

On exchange programme, some teachers of Alberta University will work as visiting Professors and carry out research programme in BUET.

The programme will be funded by the Canadian government through University of Alberta.
