## BUET classes

The undergraduate classes of all faculties of Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology (BUET) resume today (Saturday) after a month's unscheduled closure by the authorities to turn down the student's two-point demand—cancellation of class test system and increased rate of stipends. The residential halls were opened on Friday.

The BUET authorities announced that the class test system would be retained for the greater interest of the students.

The Students Action Committee rejected the decision of BUET and expressed strong resentment. It will continue the movement till the demands are met.

A procession was brought out on the campus in support of the demands on Friday night.
