Ex-Kuet VC, ex-BCL leader among 15 sued over assaulting students in 2017

Two cases have been filed against 15 people, including former vice-chancellor of Khulna University of Engineering and Technology (Kuet) Professor Mohammed Alamgir Hossain, on charge of assaulting two students in 2017.

Former pro-VC Prof Sobhan Miah, and former BCL president of the university unit Safayet Hossain Noyon are also among the accused.

Two former Kuet students -- Lutfur Rahman and Mahdi Hasan -- filed the cases with Khan Jahan Ali Police Station in Khulna on Monday.

The matter came to light after the case documents were placed before the court yesterday.

According to Officer-in-Charge Kabir Hossain of Khan Jahan Ali Police Station, Lutfur was brutally assaulted on the night of May 1, 2017, inside the guest room of Lalon Shah Hall. The overnight

torture led to the failure of both his kidneys. On the same night, another student, Mahdi Hasan, was also physically assaulted, resulting in serious injuries to his eyes.

Following a petition filed by the victims with the Khulna Metropolitan Magistrate Court on February 16 this year, the court reviewed the plea and directed police to record the case. In compliance with the court order, police officially registered the cases on Monday, the OC said.
