

BUET students resent class test system

The all-party Students Action Committee of Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology (BUET) rejected the decision of Academic Council on Monday. The Academic Council in an emergency meeting held on Sunday under the chairmanship of the Vice-Chancellor Prof. M. H. Khan decided to retain the present

class test system.

The students of BUET are on strike since October 15 in support of their two point demands which include enhancement of stipends and cancellation of class test system. The BUET student are getting stipends at the rate of Taka 100 per month which has remained unchanged for the last two decades. Moreover the board stipend holders are deprived of technical stipends. The student demand doubling of the present amount of stipends.

Meanwhile, the students held a rally in protest against the decision of Academic Council on Monday.
