BUET students to continue class boycott

BUET Students Action Committee (BSAC) leaders at a press conference yesterday challenged the university authority to show some real statistics about the benefit derived from the class test system since its introduction three years back.

The press conference held at the eentral cafeteria of the University, was addressed by Messrs Zobayer Ahmed of Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD), Nazrul Islam Manik of Bangladesh Chhatra League (SR), Matiur Rahman of Samajtantrik Chhatra Front, Mujibur Rahman of Chhatra Union and Nazrul Hasan Rana of BCL (M-N).

Asked by a journalist Mr Zober Ahmed, Senior Vice-President of JCD ridiculed the claim by the authority that BUET had earned worldwide recognition due to class test system and said that the students studying through this system had not yet passed from BUET.

Meanwhile, BSAC has decided to submit a memorandum to the University Grants Commission this week and hold a seminar on class test system next week, and will continue class boycott till a solution is reached which will be acceptable to all quarters.

About 20 final year students of civil and electrical engineering departments attended their classes yesterday. But the teachers did not take any class due to shortage of required percentage of students
