BIT teachers boycott classes

The teachers of Bangladesh Institute of Technology (BIT) at Rajshahi have been abstaining from attending their classes since December 27 last year in protest against the alleged misconduct of some students towards a senior teacher.

The incidents ensued when the students assaulted the Head of the Department of Rajshahi BIT and forced him to leave the campus raising allegation of poor pass percentage in the year final examination. The students gheraoed the residence of the teacher and took the resignation letter by force.

Following the incidents, a meeting of the Teachers' Council was held under the chairmanship of Acting Director of Rajshahi BIT in which the teachers decided to boycott the classes till a solution is reached. No steps have yet been taken to resolve the issue, it is learnt.
