BUET class test system modified

The authority of Bangladesh University of Engineering & Technology (BUET) has decided to introduce a new class test system from the session 1986-87 modifying the former system.

In a meeting of the academic council held on Wednesday night the university authority decided to reduce the percentage of marks earmarked for the class test of

each subject from 20 to 10. Some minor changes have also been made in the rules of the class test system announced earlier, it is learnt.

The students of BUET boycotted classes from October 15 to December 7 and from December 24 to January 4 to press home their two demands — abolition of class test system and the enhancement of the amount of the scholarship money.

A senior member of the academic council told this correspondent that the grievances of the students regarding the former class test system had been removed in the new system. He hoped that the students will withdraw their continuous strike programme as their major demand had been met.
