

Non-govt teachers to go on strike from tomorrow

Speakers at a protest meeting of the Bangladesh Federation of Teachers Association (BFTA) on Saturday urged the Government to immediately introduce service rules and pay scales for the teachers of the non-government colleges, schools and madrasahs in the interest of a congenial atmosphere in the educational institutions.

Presided over by Moulana Abdul Baten, Convener of the City BFTA, the meeting was held at the Islamic Foundation auditorium on Saturday to discuss future programmes of the BFTA.

The speakers expressed their determination to continue their struggle until the realisation of the five-point demand of the teachers.

The demands included, service rules and pay-scale, end of discrimination in matter of education facilities between the students of Government and non-Government schools.

The meeting resolved that all the teachers of non-government colleges, schools and madrasahs would go on strike on November 28 for the realisation of five-point demand.

The meeting was addressed, among others, by Prof Shariful Islam, Secretary General, Bangladesh College Teachers Association, Mr Abdur Rab Mia and Mohammed Abdul Baten, Joint Secretaries, Dacca city unit of Bangladesh Federation of Teachers Association (BFTA).

Meanwhile, students organisations Samajbadi Chhatra Jote and Jatiya Chhatra Front have lent the support to five-point demand of the teachers.

College teachers strike continues
