The newly elected representatives of the Rajshahi University Central Students' Union (Rucusu) took their oaths of office today.

The ceremony was held at 5:00pm at the university's Kazi Nazrul Islam Auditorium, where Vice-Chancellor and Rucusu President Prof Saleh Hasan Naqib administered the oath to the elected leaders, including Vice President (VP) Mostakur Rahman Zahid and General Secretary (GS) Salauddin Ammar. All other elected representatives were also sworn in.

The programme, chaired by the Chief Election Commissioner of Rucusu Prof F Nazrul Islam, began with a welcome address by Rucusu Election Commissioner Prof Abdul Hannan, who expressed gratitude for the successful completion of the long-awaited polls.

"After 35 long years, we have finally been able to hold this much-anticipated election. I extend special thanks to our honourable vice-chancellor for taking this bold initiative. He was the first to announce a student union election in Bangladesh after assuming office," he said.
