Dhaka University pro-vice-chancellor Professor Mamun Ahmed in his recent 15-day visit to China has exchanged views on issues of mutual interest, especially on further strengthening joint cooperative education and research activities between the DU and various institutions in China.

He made the visit at the invitation of the president of Shanghai Institutes for International Studies, said a press release on Saturday.

During the visit, he joined a fellowship programme titled Higher Education and Public Health Sector: Lessons from China, which was organised by the SIIS.

He also held separate meetings with SIIS president Chen Dongxiao, senior officials of China International Communications Group, vice-president of the Academy of Contemporary China and World Studies and senior officials of the Tongji University.

He also discussed undertaking joint cooperative education and research activities in the areas of language and culture, teacher-student exchange and knowledge and experience exchange with Chinese institutions.

He also discussed to organise an international seminar on artificial intelligence at Dhaka University with the cooperation of China and the establishment of an Oceanography Research Centre at the DU.
