Ducsu revokes Sheikh Hasina's lifetime membership

VP Shadik Kayem says decision to confer lifetime membership was unconstitutional and undemocratic



Dhaka University Central Students' Union (Ducsu) has annulled the lifetime membership it conferred on Sheikh Hasina in 2019.

The decision was announced at a press briefing held on Wednesday night by Ducsu Vice President Abu Shadik Kayem, following the union's second general meeting.

"Granting Sheikh Hasina the lifetime membership was illegal and beyond the scope of Ducsu's constitution. It was passed through an undemocratic resolution in 2019. In today's meeting, the resolution has been officially revoked," Shadik told reporters.

The general meeting was held at 6:00pm on Wednesday in the Ducsu conference room, presided over by Dhaka University Vice-Chancellor and Ducsu President Prof Niaz Ahmed Khan. Members of the full executive council, including the VP, GS, and AGS, were also present.
