## 102 BUET teachers abroad

About 39 per cent teachers of Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology (BUET) are staying abroad from higher studies, according to the annual report of BUET for the year 1984-85 published in July, 1986.

A total of 102 out of 337 teachers are now abroad. Another 13 teachers have resigned from their posts. A number of teachers have also been dismissed, the annual report said.

In the Faculty of Electrical and Electronics 25 out of 69 teachers are now abroad for higher studies. Three teachers have resigned from their posts. In Civil Engineering Faculty, 39 out of 104 teachers are on study leave in foreign countries.

Six teachers have resigned from their posts while another four have been dismissed. In Mechanical Engineering Department, 18 out of 41 teachers are on study leave in foreign countries. In Chemical Engineering Department, eight out of 22 teachers are staying abroad the annual report said.
