school teachers sanctioned

The Government has sanctioned Taka 35 37 01.472 as the third instalment of its grant as salaries and allowances to the teachers and employees of government secondary schools colleges and madrasha for the months of December Januars and February of the 1985-86 fee cal year an official handout said in Dhaka on Thursday night, resports BSS.

The money already been placed with Agrani Sonali Rupali and Janata Banks.

The increments at the enhanced rate under the revised pay scale effective from January 1986 for the secondary school teachers and employees have also been included with the amount.

The handout pointed out that the government has taken this step considering the coming holy ramzan and Eid-ul-Fitr. Arran gements have also been made to pay the third instalment of salaries and government allowances to those teachers who did not join the strike or those striking secondary school tea. chers who have resumed their duties at the call of the Government.
