

## Educational clinic

It has become a necessary evil and at the same time a fashion for the guardians to engage the tutors as desired by the class teachers for their wards. During Pakistan and British periods private tuition was in vogue for the passing out of the ill fated third division students. Auto-promotion in 1971 is responsible for the weakness thrust in general students.

For the purpose of maintaining a proper standard of teaching and education in the school and colleges. I request the guardians to ask the private tutors who may be school teachers or outsiders to enter into a contract with them with regard to the time they will require to remove the basic defects of their wards and ascertain the number of students in the class having similar defects.
