Board exam results

Sometimes it seems that the board results cause an unimaginable headache to a great number of students as well as their relatives instead of causing an immediate sense of relief among them. As per the present system of publication of the board results many of the concerned people cannot know their result as immediately as possible after the publication of the results.

The newspapers are of course, supplied with the copies of the result sheets of all the boards. But that can serve no useful purpose to all the concerned students. No newspaper can print all

the results at a time on one day. It (newspaper) cannot even publish the entire result sheet of one board only in a day. As the results of four boards are published at a time the newspapers are placed in a very awkward situation. The newspapers cannot publish the full result sheets of four boards even in seven days. But even if the newspapers decide to publish the full result sheets within six or seven days that will have little charm or meaning to the concerned people (the students and their relatives).

In the meantime thousands of students or their guardians obviously eager to know their results overcrowd each and every newspaper office for days together for which the people of all the newspapers are very much disturbed. But the newspapers fail to satisfy all the eager people in this way and sometimes they are compelled even to misbehave with these people.

Obviously the situations become more complicated for the students living outside the city areas. We therefore, feel that some easier

and wider system of publication of board results must be found out by all the concerned authorities with a view to minimising the public suffering knowing the examination results as immediately as possible.

In this connection we think that some of the following measures may be examined: (a) two parties (press or newspaper) in each big town may be particularly assigned to publish the whole results of a particular board (in which jurisdiction the town lies) on one day as special result bulletin. Or (b) all the national dailies may be asked to bring out a special result sheet with the full result of at least one board. Or (c) each of the boards should publish printed result sheet of its own and sell it at the lowest price through different schools and colleges under the same board.

We believe much of the peoples' sufferings may be done away with by adopting any of the above methods.
