



## BUET : Far from normal

BUET has officially reopened on 26th last but the situation is still murky there. The halls have opened on the 25th and exams are continuing since Nov 12 with special permission for the examinees to reside in the halls.

The eight party students alliance is demanding abolishing of the class test system.

The guardians want that there should be some fixed rules for class tests. The way things are, the situation is yet to be normal at BUET.

## RU closure

RU is closed again. This time due to a clash between the supporters of Islamic Chhatra Shibir and Central Students Action Committee which claimed two lives and injured 70 others.

This the second time that RU has been closed due to clashes in the last three months. Leading to more than two months of unscheduled closure.

It is gathered that a poster is the crux of the latest problem. The poster belonging to Islami Chatra Shibir was damaged by a CSAC member. The Shibir members protested this move of CSAC who refuted it and changed

Shibir for creating panic at the campus.

On Nov 18 the Shibir supporters attacked the CSAC supporters at Amir Ali and Abdul Latif Hall. The CSAC made a counter attack. Being unable to control the situation the RU administration appealed to the police to step in, who came but did not do anything. Some quarters feel had they acted on time Asgar Ali and Aslam Hossain could be saved.

Terror gripped Rajshahi town and the Rajshahi Medical College too had to be closed the next day putting the students in uncertainty.
