## Accommodation problem in Magura pry. schools

MAGURA, Mar. 1—A total of 259 Government and non-government Primary Schools in Magura District has been lacking in accommodation/crisis, shortage of

furniture, educational appliances as well as inadequate number of teachers. In four upazilas of Magura district, a good number of schools has been in disarray due to the said problems.

The students of the aforesaid institutions with insufficient sitting facilities are to sit either on bricks or mats.

As many as 75 thousand students of the schools have not yet received required number of books distributed free of cost under the universal primary education.

Repairing of schools is also being ignored. Many school houses damaged by cyclone and other natural calamities are left unrepared. Pure drinking water and good latrine system are also other problems. A good number of the tubewells is lying out of order for a long time.

People of the areas urged the concerned authorities to take immediate steps.
