

25 colleges to have Computer Science course

BARISAL, Apr 20: The government has undertaken a programme to introduce computer science course at 25 selected government colleges in six divisions of the country, reports BSS.

The programme under the "introduction of computer science course at selected government college and teachers' training project" will be implemented under the Directorate of Secondary and Higher Education during the current fiscal year.

According to an official source, of the total, this course will be introduced in two colleges in Barisal division, three in Khulna, five in Rajshahi, one in Sylhet, seven in Chittagong and seven in Dhaka division.

District-wise break up of the colleges are: Dhaka College, Begum Badrunnessa Government Womens! College and Government Womens' College and Government Shaheed Suhrawardy College in Dhaka district, Government Bangabandhu College in Gopalgonj, Mominunnessa Government Womens' College in Mymensingh, Government Ashek Mahmud College in Jamalpur, Government Moulana Mohammad Ali College in Tangail, Chittagong Government Womens' College and Chittagong Commerce College in Chittagong, Rangamati Government College in Rangamati. Bandarban Government College in Bandarban, Noakhali Government Womens' College in Noakhali, Victoria Government College and Comilia Government Womens' College in Comilla, Sylhet Government College in Sylhet, New Government Degree College in Rajshahi, Pabna Government Womens' College in Pabna, Begum Rokeya Government College in Rangpur, Shah Sultan Government College in Bogra, Dinajpur Government Womens' College in Dinajpur, Khulna Government Womens' College in Khulna, Jessore Government Womens' College in Jessore, Kushtia Government Womens' College in Kushtia, Barisal Government Womens' College in Barisal and Patuakhali Government Womens' College in Patuakhali district.
