BUET team calls on President

A six-member delegation of Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology (BUET) led by Vice-Chancellor Prof. M. Shahjahan called on President Abdur Rahman Biswas at Bangabhaban on Saturday, reports BSS.

The delegation members warmly felicitated the President on assuming the office of the presidency.
