8832 posts of teachers lying vacant

Education Minister Sheikh Shahidul Islam informed the Jatiya Sangsad yesterday that a total of 8,832 posts of teachers in the universities, government colleges, government secondary schools and government primary schools were lying vacant, reports BSS.

The number of vacant posts in the universities were 688, in colleges 1,850, in secondary schools 495 and in primary schools 5,799.

Repling to a question from Mr Abu Lais Md Mubin Chowdhury (JP-Habiganj), the minister said the government had a plan to fill up those vacant posts.

In reply to another question from Mr Ataurul Rahman (COP-Sirajganj), the Education Minister told the Jatiya Sangsad that guidelines for appointment of primary school teachers were being formulated and decisions would be taken in this regard in the light of

Replying to another question from Wing Commander (ret'd) Zahirul Islam (JP-Cox's Bazar), he said that with regard to college teachers, the posts of lecturers were to be filled through the BCS examinations taken under the Public Service Commission. For this purpose BCS examinations had already been held in 1986 and 1987.

He said that rules for filling up the vacant posts of Assistant Professors and above through promotions were at the final stage of preparation and the posts would be filled up after the finalisation of rules.
