

Prof Z Huq gets Qudrat-e-Khuda Award-81

Prof. A.M. Zahoorul Huq, an eminent educationist and author of science books was awarded the 'Dr. Qudrat-e-Khuda Award-81' by the Chittagong Science Parishad, reports BSS.

The award was introduced by the Parishad in 1979 to honour the eminent scientists engaged in science culture in Bengali.

Prof. Huq, now a teacher in Electrical Engineering at the Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology wrote more than a dozen of science books in Bengali. Some of them are 'Jiban o Biggyan', 'Biggyan Niyata Sangi', 'Sagarer Sesh Nei' and 'Manusher Sakti', besides he also wrote a number of essays, and has many professional publications to his credit. He also translated a number of science books in Bengali.

Prof. Huq was awarded the UNESCO prize for literature in 1960, National Book Prize for scientific literature in 1969 and Bangla Academy Award for essay and research in 1980.

His biography was included in the international directories of 'Who's who in Education' and 'Directory of International Biography'. He has visited a number of countries as an academician and a professional.
