

Three groups fight DUTA election

Election of the executive body of Dhaka University Teachers Association will be held on Thursday.

All the three groups of DU teachers—blue, white and pink—have put up their candidates in the election.

Prof Moshihuzzaman of Chemistry Department and Dr MA Mannan of Management Department will contest from the blue panel for for posts they are now holding—president and general secretary. The white panel candidates for the posts of president and general secretary are Prof. Yeazuddin Ahmed (Soil

Science) and Mr. Nurul Islam (Mathematics).

Prof K A M Saad Uddin of Sociology and Mr Ferdous Hossain of Political Science are the two candidates for the posts of president and general secretary nominated by the pink panel.

About 850 teachers of the University will elect 15 DUTA executives for a one-year term. Casting of votes will be held from 10 am to 1 pm at the DU club building. Dr S A Latifur Reza of Economics Department will conduct the election.

shifted in view of the campus violence that left one student dead and several others injured late in November.

The teachers of the University will vote tomorrow to select their six representatives to the 17-member Syndicate. Of the six, one each will be elected from among the deans, provosts, professors, associate professors, assistant professors and lecturers of the DU.

A total of 16 candidates will contest for the six posts from the white, blue and pink panels of the teachers. The white panel-nominated candidates are: Dr Anwarullah Choudhury (dean, social science), Dr SMA Fayez (Professor, soil science), renowned novelist Dr. Humayun Ahmed (associate professor, chemistry) and Dr. Anwar Hossain (assistant professor, bio-chemistry) and Mr ABM Shahiduddin (lecturer, marketing).

The white panel could not nominate anyone for the post of provosts' representative as its candidate Dr K M Mohsin, Provost of Salimullah Hall, resigned over the killing a student of his hall on November 29.

The blue panel has nominated Prof. M. Aminul Islam (Dean of Science), Mr. Mahtabuddin (Provost of Shahidullah Hall), Mr. Aminul Islam (Professor of Soil Science), Mr A T M Jahurul Huq (associate professor of economics), Mr. Mostafa Choudhury (assistant professor of political science) and Dr Emdad Hossain (lecturer of botany).

The candidates of pink panel are: Mr. AFM Khodadad Khan (Provost of Ziaur Rahman Hall), Mr Abdul Momin Choudhury (professor of history) Dr Nazrul Islam (associate professor of sociology), Mr Mizanur Rahman (assistant professor of marketing) and Mr Bidyut Kanti (lecturer of pharmacy).
