

## United move needed against session jam, violence

Speakers at an open forum entitled "session jam and its prevention" on Saturday for building up national consciousness against session jam and violence on the university campuses, reports BSS. It was arranged to mark the

concluding day of the four-day long "BUET festival '92" at Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology (BUET).

Speakers underscored the need for collective efforts to identify the causes of session jam and violence on a priority basis. The reasons were political and it would have to be tackled politically, they added.

"Students played their due role during any crisis of the nation and this is the time to be united against session jam and violence" they said.

Terming violence as the major cause for session jam, they said united initiatives were necessary so that the terrorists could not take shelter in any political party.

They said students' politics would not be free from crisis until the leadership belonged to the regular students. They urged for removing the non-students from leadership.
