

violence over: cricket match 2 DU teachers assaulted: car set ablaze

Two Dhaka University teachers were assaulted and a private car was set ablaze at the Jagannath Hall play ground on Saturday following a dispute between the students of Management and Finance Departments over a controversial run out decision in the Inter-De partment Cricket Tournament.

The Management Department won the match by two runs.

Finance Department scored 154 runs for 9 wickets and in reply the Management Department made 156 runs for 7 wickets.

The dispute ensued when Finance students manhandled the umpire Shishir over the controversial run out at the end of the match. The car set afire belonged to Prof Abdul Momin Chowdhury of History Depart-

A heavy contingent of police was deployed in the area. The police brought the situation under control.
