BUET semester exam date shifted

The date of second semester Examination (Part-'B') of the students of 2nd, 3rd and 4th year classes of session 1990-91 and 4th year classes of session 1989-90 of Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology (BUET) has been shifted.

According to the new examination schedule, the Part-'B' examination which was earlier scheduled to be held on August 15 will now begin from August 29.

The decision to change the duty of examination was taken in a meeting of the Academic Council of BUET on August 5 following an incident on August 2 in which police, deployed inside the BUET Campus, lobbed teargas shells at a procession brought out by the BUET students demanding an acceptable revised examination schedule of 6 weeks duration instead of 4 weeks, set earlier by the BUET authorities.

As a consequence of the police attack on the students, the leaders of EUCSU and All Party's Students Unity (APSU) of BUET in a protest rally at BUET cafeteria premises on August 3, blamed the BUET Vice-Chancellor for the incident and demanded his resignation.

The new examination schedule will now have a duration of 8 weeks.
