

Convocation of BUET tomorrow

The fourth convocation of Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology (BUET) will be held on Saturday (May 8), reports UNB.

Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia, who is also the Chancellor of the BUET, will preside over the convocation and distribute certificates and medals among the recipients.

BUET Vice-Chancellor Prof. Mohammad Shajahan and Prof. Muhammad Yunus will also address the function.

Certificates will be distributed among 506 students for the session of 1988-89. Of whom, 466 will get B.Sc, one Ph.D and 40 Post-graduate degrees.

The convocation will also award gold medals to 20 people for their outstanding performances.

A total of 10,203 students had degrees from the University since the University was established in 1962.

BSS adds: The first convocation of BUET was held on March 20, 1973 while the second and third convocations were held on November 12, 1976 and February 29, 1992.

A steering committee has been formed with Prof. Sohrab Uddin Ahmed of Civil Engineering Department and Md. Asad Ullah Khan, the Controller of Examinations as the President and the Member-Secretary respectively for holding the convocation successfully.
