BAU teachers' token work stoppage today

Bangladesh Agriculture University teachers will observe token work stoppage today (Saturday) seeking punishment of the students involved in violence following legal action against unfair means adopted in examination, reports UNB.

They will bring out a silent procession today (Saturday) in protest against the students' "terrorist" activities, according to the decision of a meeting of the BAU Teachers Association held on Thursday at the varsity in Mymensingh.

The teachers will refrain from conducting the annual examination of 3rd year Agro-engineering class until deterrent punishment is given to the rowdy students.

The BAUTA meeting, held with its President Prof M Manzurul Amin in the chair, condemned the indiscipline and terrorist activities like ransacking of the chambers of two teachers by the students following action against unfair means adopted in the annual examination of 3rd year Agro-Engineering class on May 11.

It demanded exemplary punishment of the students involved in the incidents.

The association in a general meeting on June 2 will review steps to be taken by the University authorities to punish the guilty and adopt next course of action.

The meeting demanded security of all teachers, including Mohammad Ali Basunia, an Assistant Professor of the university.
