BUET APSU for expediting arrest of Ahmedullah's killers

All Party Student Unity (APSU) of BUET at a press conference on Thursday demanded arrest and punishment of the killers of Ahmedullah.

The APSU leaders said even after forty-days of Ahmedullah's killing none was arrested. The leaders condemned the role of police administration for its failure to arrest any person in connection with Ahmedullah's killing incident.

Ahmedullah, a fourth year student of civil engineering of Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology (BUET) was shot dead by some unknown miscreants on BUET campus on June 3.

The leaders demanded withdrawal of ban on student politics in the BUET campus.

The APSU leaders urged the government to take necessary step to arrest the killers of Ahmedullah.

The press conference held at Central Cafeteria of BUET, was attended, among others, by Jahangir Alam of Jatiyatabadi Chhatra League (S-P).
