

BUETTA to hand over memo to PM

BUET teachers will bring out a silent procession and march towards the Secretariat today to hand over a memorandum to Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina, said President of the Association Prof Abdur Razzak Akand yesterday.

BUETTA, which is observing an indefinite strike since May 5, has already shifted its programme for silent procession twice during the last few days.

"An appointment on behalf of the BUETTA was sought with the Chancellor on May 6," said an executive committee member of the BUETTA, adding that no response has yet been received.

Stalemate at the BUET persists as the teachers went into an indefinite strike from May 5, following resignation by Prof Iqbal Mahmud from his post of Vice Chancellor and 71 other teachers from their administrative posts.

Prof Iqbal Mahmud had resigned from his post on May 4 protesting interference from higher authorities in the university affairs.
