The BUET Teachers' Association in the meeting on Monday urged the Chancellor of the university Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina to implement the memorandum of the assor ciation. It asserted that the university would not accept any interference from the government or outsiders.

The meeting reminded the government of not showing any discrepancy in extending cooperation to the university.

Though the meeting refused to accept the resignation of 71 teachers it remained silent over the withdrawal of resignation letters of 13 teachers of Architecture Department of the university who resigned protesting the change of the system of admission test by the university.
