BUET teachers to submit memo to PM Wednesday

The BUET Teachers' Association will bring out a silent procession on Wednesday and march towards the Prime Minister's Office (PMO) to handover a memorandum to the Chancellor of the university. According to BUET sources, the decision was taken at a meeting of the executive committee of BUETTA yesterday.

The BUETTA, which has been observing an indefinite strike since May 5, in a general meeting earlier on Thursday had decided to march towards

the PMO 'sometime' this week if the crisis at the university persisted. Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina is the Chancellor of BUET.

"There has been no development in resolving the crisis at BUET," Prof Abdur Razzak Akand, president of BUETTA, told The Daily Star yesterday.

The silent procession that begins at 9:00 am on Wednesday will first parade the campus and then march towards the PMO to handover the memorandum, he added.

An appointment with the Chancellor was sought on behalf of BUETTA on May 6 but no response has yet been received, a BUETTA leader said.
