Applications are invited from bonafide citizens of Bangladesh for selection on candidates for Commonwealth Scholarships tenable in the U.K., Canada and other Commonwealth countries and also for Cambridge Commonwealth Trust Awards (For study in Cambridge University only) for higher studies at post-graduate/Research level in the subjects mentioned below from the academic year 1989-90.

2. The candidates who fulfil the minimum academic qualifications mentioned against the subjects below, and other conditions should only apply:

- i) Economics, Agricultural Economics, Public Administration, Educational Planning, Business Administration, Management, Marketing, Accounting, Finance, Geography, English, Sociology/Rural Sociology, Psychology, Philosophy, History/Islamic History, Archaeology, International Relations, Law, Political Science, Journalism & Mass Communication, Linguistics, Fine Arts.
- ii) Physics/Applied Physics and Electronics, Computer Science, Applied Chemistry/Chemistry/Soil Science, Mathematics, Statistics, Zoology, Botany, Geology, Histology with Tissue Culture, Pharmacy, Bio-Chemistry, Food Technology/Nutrition, Microbiology, Marine Biology, Forestry.

- iii) Agriculture (all branches) First class B.Sc. (Agriculture) with First Division in SSC and HSC Examinations.
- iv) Engineering (all branches) including Architecture and Computer Engineering First class B.Sc. (Engg.) including B.Sc. (Architecture) with 1st Division in SSC and HSC examinations.
- v) Textile Technology/Leather Technology (all branches) Must have a degree in Textile Technology/Leather Technology preferable with 1st division in SSC or HSC and at least a Second Division in the other.
- vi) Urban and Regional Planning. Master Degree in Urban & Regional Planning with 1st class in Civil Engg. or Architecture or with a Master's degree in Economics, Sociology or Geography, having at least one 1st class either in Hon's or in Master degree.
- vii) Medical Science (all branches) M.B.B.S./B.D.S. Degree (regular with 1st Division in SSC or HSC Examinations. Candidates

should possess qualifications registerable with General Medical Council in the U.K.

3. Commonwealth Scholarships in Medical subjects are available in U.K. only. Medical candidates who are interested in doing M.R.C.P., F.R.C.S. etc. shall be given preference if they have already completed first of such examination.
4. Candidates should not be over 35 years of age on 1st October, 1989. Applicants already holding a Doctorate degree are not eligible.
5. Persons in service must apply through proper channel. Candidates who availed of Government sponsored scholarships for a period of 3 (three) months and above but have not completed a minimum period of 5 years services/stay in Bangladesh on return from abroad, are not eligible.
6. Candidates may be required to appear for a proficiency test in English to be conducted by the British Council, Dhaka.
7. Seven copies of type written applications as per the specimen proforma shown below (together with only one set of attested copies of certificates, diplomas, degree, marksheets, testimonilas, etc.) should reach the undersigned by October 31, 1988, at the latest. Applicants may also drop their applications in the wooden box kept in the reception room, 2nd gate, Bangladesh Secretariat, Dhaka. Incomplete application and those received after the last date will automatically stand rejected.
