### Explosions at DU Laboratory School: 2 students held

Police yesterday picked up two students of University Laboratory School in connection with the explosion of several bombs in the school premises in last two days.

School sources said the bombs were exploded in demand for shifting of the date of the pre-test examinations. Nobody was however hurt in the explosions. The Vice-Chancellor of the Dhaka University after visiting the spot formed a committee to probe the incident.

The school is run by the Institute of Education and Research of the university.

Police forces deployed at the school recovered two live bombs and arrested the two students, identified as Ataur Rahman alias Arif and Harun-or-Rashid, who are candidates for the pre-test examinations.

School sources said that some of the examinees a few days back demanded of the principal to shift the date of examinations, but it was rejected and the examinations began on Monday as per schedule.

The Vice-chancellor while speaking at a function said that the bomb-throwers were learnt to be children of some of the university staff admitted into the school on quota basis. The responsibility of the violent activities must be taken by their guardians, the Vice-chancellor warned.
